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CHI Coalitions

- *32 local CHI coalitions* have been created since 2001
 - Over *150,000* children enrolled in health coverage, *82,000* newly enrolled
 - Some programs expanding to include adults
 - *Statewide collaboration enabling policy change*

Expansion of CHI Model Statewide

- 11 Children's Health Initiatives (w/ Healthy Kids products) currently operational in the Greater Bay Area, Los Angeles, Inland Empire, San Joaquin Valley and Central Coast.
 - In the next 6 months, 11 more CHIs will launch with the potential of between 11-15 by the end of 2006.
 - Two new regional CHIs will launch by early 2006 - North Bay and Sierra Sacramento Valley regions
